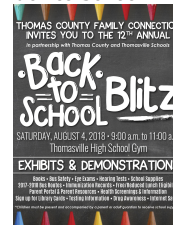
Terry Howell, will speak about the U. S. Naval Academy

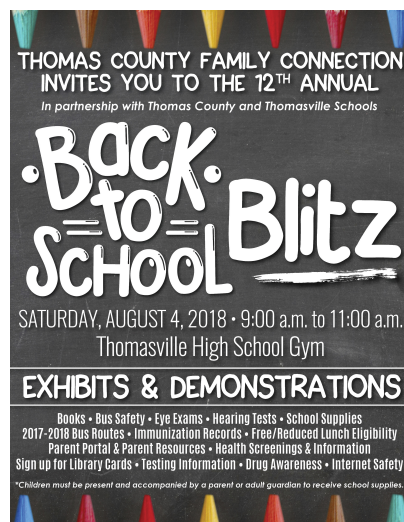
